



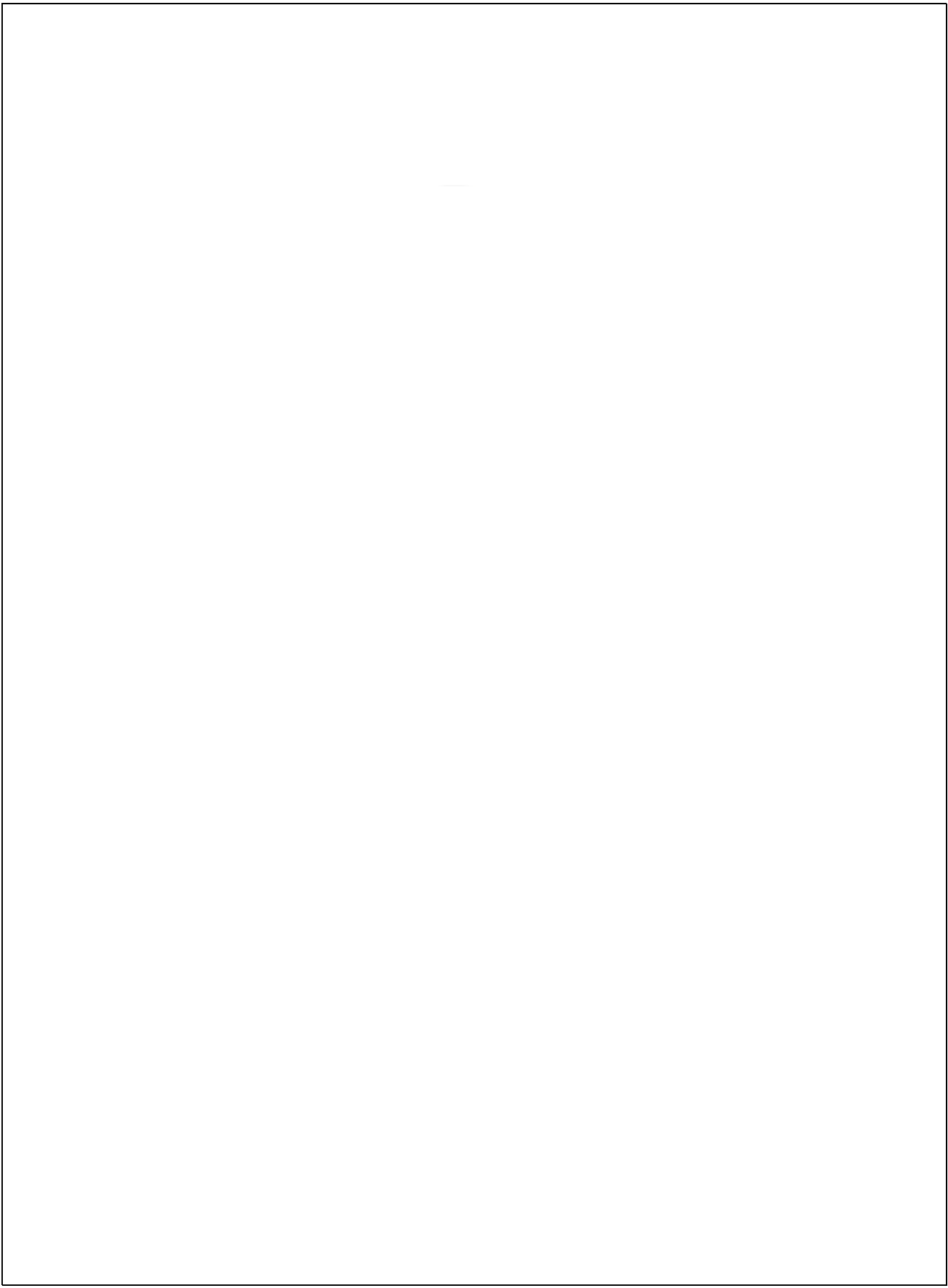
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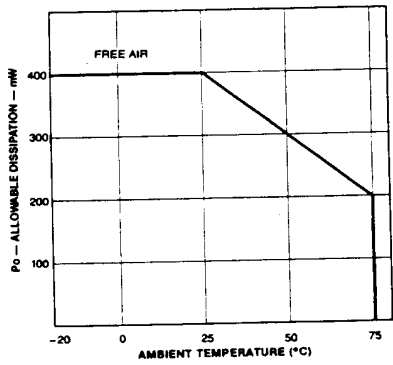


Figure 2. Allowable Dissipation vs. Ambient Temperature

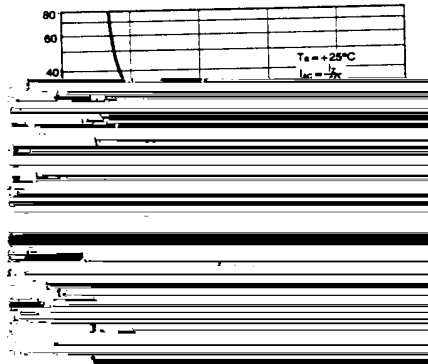


Figure 3. Dynamic Resistance vs. Zener Current

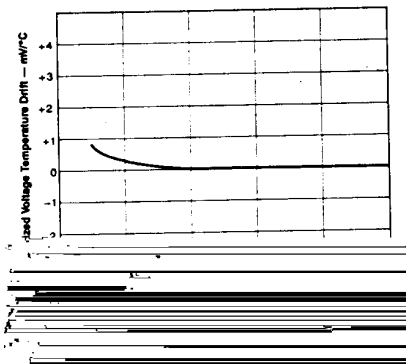


Figure 4. Stabilized Voltage Temperature Drift vs. Zener Current

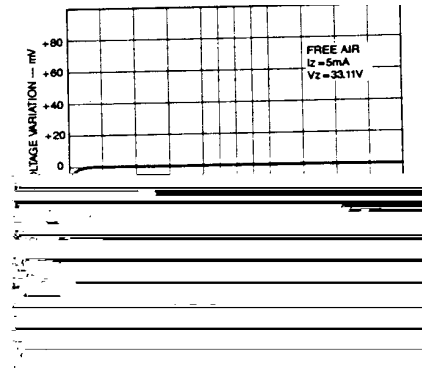


Figure 5. Stabilized Voltage Variation vs. Time

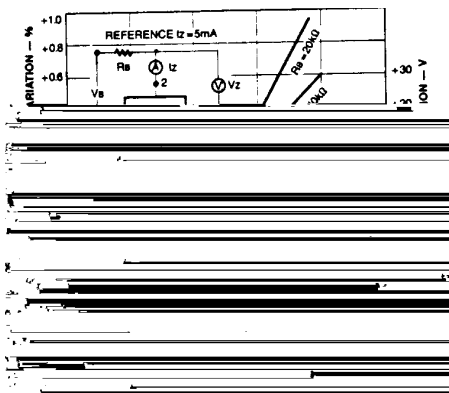


Figure 6. Stabilized Voltage Variation & Supply Voltage Variation vs. Zener Current

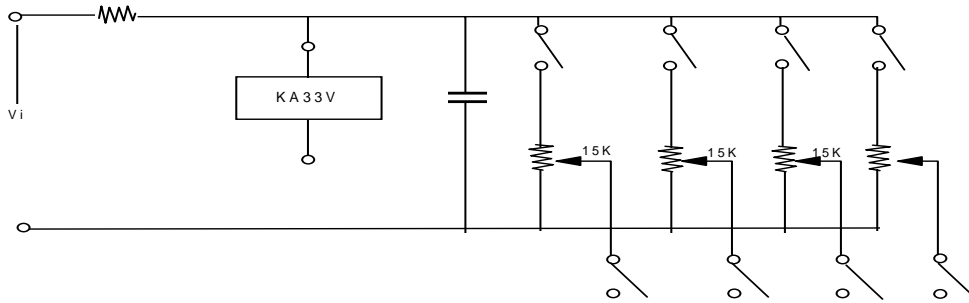


Figure 9. Electronic Tuner
